WHEREAS, it has been determined it is necessary, in consultation with the Stillwater Township Committee and the Stillwater Township Clerk to implement certain restrictions in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of Town Employees, and volunteers, and members of the general public;

Therefore, be it ordered, that I, Lisa Chamings, Stillwater Emergency Management Coordinator, do hereby order the following, Effective 8:00 AM, Wednesday, March 18, 2020.

1. Our Municipal Building at 964 Stillwater Road will be closed to the public for general business. Employees are still expected at work during their regularly scheduled shifts and all municipal business should be conducted via mail, email, telephone or as possible website.
2. The Recycling Center will be open for business unless it is deemed necessary to close it
3. Our DPW building will only be accessed by our employees.
4. All fields, parks, playgrounds at Stillwater Park, Veterans Park, and Volunteer field will be closed to the organized sports. Residents will still be allowed to participate in walks or hikes or fishing unless it is deemed necessary due to ever changing conditions and data to close them completely to the public.
5. The Stillwater Township Community Center at 931 Swartswood Road will be closed until further notice.
6. The Planning board meeting scheduled for March 18, 2020 has been cancelled.
7. The need for a Zoning Board meeting scheduled for March 23, 2020 is being determined at this time
8. The Stillwater Township Clean Up Day will be assessed by March 30th, 2020 for either taking place or being postponed to a later date.

These restrictions will remain in place by order of the Township Committee or by the Stillwater Office of Emergency Management. Thank you for understanding.
