Re: Stillwater Township Clean-Up Day

Dear Coordinator:

This year Stillwater Township Clean-Up Day will be held on Saturday, September 26, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The following guidelines have been established to meet the state requirements to be eligible to receive the Clean Communities Grant Funds.

- To receive the grant money you **must** be a non-profit organization (state requirement).
- You must sign in at the Recycling Center, so that we can record the number of participants taking part in Clean-Up Day (state requirement). **All participating members of your group must check in at the Recycling Center, not just the coordinator.**
- You must bring your garbage/recyclables back to the Stillwater Recycling Center for sorting, if necessary, and weighing (state requirement). There will be a limit on tires being brought back to the center, and the number will be given along with your confirmation letter.
- We ask that you have a minimum of 5-7 people in your non-profit group to be eligible to receive the state funding. Please note that anyone can help your organization pick up trash, even if they are not from your group (i.e. – Great Uncle visiting from Kansas). **The disbursement amount per group will be \$300.00, pending review and approval of eligibility and confirmation of funds.**
- **We ask that your organization is in compliance with the latest CDC Guidelines for Outdoor Activities and follow SOCIAL DISTANCING and MASK wearing guidelines when social distancing isn't possible.**

- **Please call Michele Hess (973-390-1250) or email recreation@stillwatertwp.com to register if your organization is going to participate. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Participation will be limited to the first 30 groups to register.**
