WHEREAS, R.S. 52:27BB-34 authorizes the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board has promulgated N.J.A.C. 5:30-6-5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall, by resolution, certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations"; and

WHEREAS, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed, as a minimum, the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the annual Audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations", as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C .5:30-6-5; and

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provision of the R.S. 52:27BB-52 to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of the local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the Director (Director of Local Government Services), under provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Stillwater, hereby states that it has complies with N.J.A.C. 5:30-6-5 and does hereby submit a certified copy of the resolution and the required affidavit to said Board to show evidence of said compliance.

Corrective Action Plan for the Township of Stillwater 2021 Annual Audit

Recommendation #1 – An adequate segregation of duties be maintained with respect to the recording and treasury functions.

<u>Corrective Action</u> — Due to the staffing issues that exist and the use of part time workers in various positions, it is difficult to properly divide the duties of each office. Many staff workers must cover more than just their own positions each day, and it is not always practical to divide and segregate duties. The Township Committee, Clerk and Chief Finance Officer continue to examine ways to help mitigate issues to do with the segregation of duties.

Implementation Date - Ongoing

<u>Recommendation #2</u> – The records for the Township liens be reviewed and measures be taken to collect or foreclose on the liens held by the Township.

<u>Corrective Action</u> – Letters have been sent to all owners of properties on which the Township currently holds liens. Several property owners have redeemed their liens, and the Township will be completing approximately fifteen (15) In Rem foreclosures this calendar year. The Township will continue to proceed with additional foreclosures moving forward.

- (b) The average period of usefulness of said purposes within the limitations of said Local bond Law and taking into consideration the respective amounts of the said obligations authorized for the several purposes, according to the reasonable life thereof computed by this capital ordinance, is five (5) years.

<u>Section 5.</u> This capital ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by said Local Bond Law.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A PARENTS' BILL OF RIGHTS CONCERNING THE PROTECTION AND EDUCATION OF CHILDREN IN THE TOWNSHIP OF STILLWATER

- WHEREAS, legislation has been enacted by the New Jersey Legislature and signed into law by Governor Phil Murphy, the effect of which is to teach sexually specific and highly sensitive curricula to children in New Jersey and, particularly, in Stillwater Township, as early as grades K-2; and
- WHEREAS, recent guidelines provided by the New Jersey Department of Education (the 'Department of Education') and the associated sample curricula regarding same is disturbing and concerning to the parents and residents of Stillwater Township and throughout New Jersey; and
- WHEREAS, Township Council members have been contacted by residents regarding this sensitive issue; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Education's guidelines were promulgated, and the legislation passed and signed into law in 2020 and 2021, during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic when New Jersey residents were sheltering in place, preoccupied with the pandemic, and there was not sufficient time or opportunity for public comment; and
- WHEREAS, as a result of the foregoing, Stillwater Township parents specifically, and New Jersey parents generally, did not have any input into creating the sexually specific and highly sensitive curricula that will be taught to Stillwater Township children under the legislation and guidelines; and
- WHEREAS, it is the overwhelming opinion of this governing body that the decision to teach sexually specific and highly sensitive curricula to children in grades K-2 is best left to the sound discretion of those children's parents, local communities, and local districts; and
- WHEREAS, it is the overwhelming opinion of this governing body that Governor Phil Murphy and the New Jersey State Legislature have no business regulating, legislating, directing, or dictating matters that are, and should be, decided solely and exclusively by parents in said parents' best judgment as to health, safety, and welfare of their children; and
- WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council call on Governor Murphy, the New Jersey Legislature, and the Department of Education to return such decisions to local School Boards regarding such sexually specific and highly sensitive curricula for our children; and
- WHEREAS, as a show of support for Stillwater Township families, the Mayor and Council also desire to work with Township parents, community leaders, and professionals to develop the framework for a Parents' Bill of Rights to use as a model for local schools that will, among other things, protect our children, notify our parents of the curricula being taught in our schools, and allow parents to make their own informed decisions regarding their children's education and exposure to sensitive information; and
- **WHEREAS**, public interest demands that parents have an opportunity to be heard on the issue of this curricula being taught in grades K-2.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Stillwater, in the County of Sussex and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. We demand that Governor Phil Murphy, the New Jersey State Legislature, and the Department of Education ban the sexually specific and highly sensitive curricula for young children that was developed out of the aforesaid guidelines, legislation, and sample curricula.
- 2. All appropriate Township officials are authorized and directed to work with our parents, community leaders, educators, and professionals to develop the framework for a Parents' Bill of Rights to use as a model for our local schools that will serve, among other things, as a guide to protect our children, notify parents of the curricula being taught to their children in our schools, and allow parents to make their own informed decisions regarding their children's education and exposure to sensitive information.
- 3. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to forward this resolution of Governor Murphy, the New Jersey Legislature, the Department of Education, the County Superintendent of Schools, the local School Boards and private and charter schools, New Jersey League of Municipalities, all County Boards of County Commissioners, the Mayors and governing bodies of all municipalities within Sussex County, and the New Jersey State Board of Education.
- 4. This resolution and contract shall be available for public inspection in the office of the Township Clerk.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
