TOWNSHIP OF STILLWATER AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTAGUE FOR THE SERVICES OF A OUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT

RESOLUTION 2022-176

WHEREAS, the Township of Stillwater and the Township of Montague have agreed to enter into a Shared Services Agreement by which the Township of Stillwater shall provide Qualified Purchasing Agent services to the Township of Montague pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., and

WHEREAS, the Township of Stillwater and the Township of Montague agree to enter into the attached Shared Services Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Stillwater Township Committee, County of Sussex and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 4. The Shared Services Agreement between the Township of Stillwater and the Township of Montague is approved pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. The terms and conditions of the Agreement (Exhibit "A") are made a part of this Resolution.
- 2. The Mayor and Township Clerk are authorized to sign the Agreement on behalf of the Township.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately, however, it shall be void and of no effect in the event that the Township of Montague fails or refuses to adopt a similar resolution and/or execute the Shared Services Agreement.
- 4. A copy of this Agreement shall be filed, for informational purposes, with the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4.

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF STILLWATER AND THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTAGUE FOR QUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT

This Shared Services Agreement ("Agreement"), effective as January 1, 2022 ("Effective Date"), is made by and between the Township of Stillwater, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey ("Stillwater"), located at 964 Stillwater Road, Newton, NJ 07860, and the Township of Montague ("Montague"), located at 277 Clove Road, Montague, NJ 07827.

The purpose of this Agreement is for Stillwater, through the Shared Services, to provide to Montague the services of a Qualified Purchasing Agent as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4, et seq.

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Uniform Shared Services and Consolidated Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq.) authorizes shared services between municipalities.

WHEREAS, Montague has a need for the services of a Qualified Purchasing Agent and has requested that Stillwater provide this service in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement.

- Nature of Agreement. This Agreement is a "Shared Services Agreement" pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq. The nature and value of the services contracted in this Agreement excepts this Agreement from the bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law, pursuant to, inter alia, N.J.S.A. 40A11-3.
- Description of Services Provided. Stillwater shall provide Montague the services of a Qualified Purchasing Agent ("QPA") as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-9, as requested from time to time by Montague. Montague shall pay Stillwater for the services on an "as needed" and "as requested" basis.
- Responsibility of Montague. Montague shall be responsible for paying Stillwater for the services
 of the QPA as provided for in Section 4 of this Agreement. Montague shall provide copies of all
 bid and quotation documents and information required by Stillwater in order to provide the QPA
 services.
- 4. <u>Costs and Payment</u>. Montague shall be billed monthly, or at such frequency as determined by Stillwater for the QPA services provided by Stillwater. The price for the services commencing on the Effective Date and for the first year of the Agreement is \$100.00 per hour. Stillwater shall bill Montague in quarter hour increments and shall provide monthly invoices to Montague for any services provided by Stillwater under this Agreement.

In accordance with Stillwater's payment policies, payments shall be made using the Stillwater invoices and vouchers system with payments due within thirty (30) days of the date of the invoice.

In the event a payment is not made within ten (10) days of its due date, it shall result in the imposition of a 5% late fee for each month or part of the month that the payment is not made.

- 5. Term of Agreement. The term of this Agreement shall end on December 31, 2021, unless terminated sooner. The parties may extend the Agreement annually for an additional term of one (1) year commencing on January 1, 2023 and ending on December 31, 2023 provided, however, that at least sixty (60) days prior to the commencement date of the renewal period the parties agree to any adjustments to the hourly rate of compensation to be paid to Stillwater from Montague. The rate shall be confirmed in writing by way of an Amendment to this Agreement. In the event that the parties are unable to agree to the adjustment of rate of compensation, either party may terminate as provided in this Agreement.
- 6. <u>Review of Agreement</u>. In the event the parties extend the term of this Agreement, they shall annually review and evaluate the nature and sufficiency of the services rendered under this Agreement and the compensation paid to Stillwater.
- 7. <u>Termination</u>. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing written notice to the other party at the address specified in this Agreement by written notice, confirmed mail delivery, no less than thirty (30) days prior to the date of termination, the notice itself shall specify the date the termination becomes effective ("termination date"). Montague shall be responsible for paying all sums owed to Stillwater for QPA services provided through the termination date upon termination of this Agreement.
- 8. Indemnification & Defense. SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF STILLWATER AND THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKFORD FOR QUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT

This Shared Services Agreement ("Agreement"), effective as January 1, 2023 ("Effective Date"), is made by and between the Township of Stillwater, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey ("Stillwater"), located at 964 Stillwater Road, Newton, NJ 07860, and the Township of Frankford ("Frankford"), located at 151 US Highway 206, Augusta, NJ 07822.

The purpose of this Agreement is for Stillwater, through the Shared Services, to provide to Frankford the services of a Qualified Purchasing Agent as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4, et seq.

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Uniform Shared Services and Consolidated Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq.) authorizes shared services between municipalities.

WHEREAS, Frankford has a need for the services of a Qualified Purchasing Agent and has requested that Stillwater provide this service in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement.
