INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPLETING THE CITIZEN LEADERSHIP FORM

On October 19 2009, Governor Corzine signed into law P.L. 2009, c. 141 also known as the "Citizen Service Act." One of the provisions of the new law requires any person interested in volunteering their services on a municipal authority, board, commission or committee to file a one-page "Citizen Leadership Form" with the Township Clerk. In completing this form, you should be aware that the law also deems several items of information on the form to restricted from public disclosure under the Open Public Records Act. The design of the form facilitates OPRA disclosure, and redaction of the restricted information by locating those fields at the bottom of the form.
