TOWNSHIP OF STILLWATER SUSSEX COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TOWNSHIP NOISE ORDDINANCE TO CLARIFY PROHIBITED ACTS AND CONFIRM ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Stillwater wishes to improve the Township Noise Ordinance to ensure that its provisions can be efficiently enforced when necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Stillwater, that the Township Code shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1

The Township Committee of the Township of Stillwater hereby amends Chapter 272 of the Township Code entitled "Noise" to add a new subsection to § 272-2 (Prohibited Acts) as follows:

I. Discharging unlawful explosive devices or discharging unlawful firearms and/or unlawful magazines or utilizing legally obtained firearms or explosives in a manner that causes or makes loud, unnecessary or unusual noise of a repetitive nature which does or is likely to annoy, disturb, injure or endanger the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of others.

SECTION 2

The Township Committee of the Township of Stillwater hereby amends Chapter 272 of the Township Code entitled "Noise" to add a new Section § 272-5 as follows:

§ 272-5 Enforcement, Violations and penalties

This Chapter shall be enforced by the New Jersey State Police. Any person who fails or refuses to comply with any lawful order or direction of a member of the State Police to cease and desist from making noise believed to be in violation of this Chapter, or who violates this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to the penalties provided in Chapter 1. Article III of the Code of the Township of Stillwater (§ 1-17 et seq.)

SECTION 3

The Township Clerk shall take all necessary action to assure the Code is promptly updated to accurately reflect the current law, policies and practices of the Township of Stillwater.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH SUSSEX COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY FOR THE PROVISION OF CERTIFIED RECYCLING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO CERTIFY AND SUBMIT THE 2022 RECYCLING TONNAGE REPORT TO NJDEP

WHEREAS, the Township of Stillwater is required to submit a Certified Recycling Tonnage Report to NJDEP for the year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Stillwater does not employ a Certified Recycling Professional required to file the Recycling Tonnage Report; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq.) (hereinafter, "the Act") provides that local units of government may enter into a contract to provide or receive any service that either local unit participating in the Agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction, including services incidental to the primary purposes of any of the participating units (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4); and

WHEREAS, Stillwater Township will prepare the 2022 Stillwater Township Recycling Tonnage Report; and

WHEREAS, Stillwater Township wishes to request the services of the SCMUA in the form of the District Recycling Coordinator as a Certified Recycling Professional to certify and submit the required 2022 Stillwater Township Tonnage Report to NJDEP by April 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, SCMUA has the qualified staff to certify the Recycling Tonnage Report prepared by Stillwater Township and electronically submit it to NJDEP on behalf of Stillwater Township under the terms and conditions set forth in the Shared Services Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Stillwater as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Shared Services Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto, with SCMUA for the provision of Certified Recycling Professional Services to certify and submit the 2022 Recycling Tonnage Report to NJDEP.
- 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
- 3. All Township Staff and Professionals are authorized to take any and all necessary actions to see to the implementation of this Resolution.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN STILLWATER TOWNSHIP AND SUSSEX COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY FOR CERTIFIED RECYCLING PROFESSIONAL (CRP) TO CERTIFY THE 2022 ANNUAL RECYCLING TONNAGE REPORT

Beginning 2013, each New Jersey municipality is required by the Recycling Enhancement Act (REA) to have mandatory Annual Recycling Tonnage Reports approved and "executed" by a Certified Recycling Professional (hereinafter "CRP"). Recycling Tonnage Reports will be submitted by the SCMUA via email to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) utilizing a spreadsheet compatible with the Microsoft Excel structure provided by the Department.

THIS AGREEMENT by and between Stillwater Township, a municipal body politic having its offices at 964 Stillwater Road, Newton, New Jersey, 07860, and the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority (SCMUA), Sussex County, New Jersey, a body corporate and body politic organized and operating pursuant to NJSA 40:14B-1 et seq. having its offices located at 34 South Route 94, New Jersey, 07848 (hereinafter SCMUA), is dated this day of , 2023.

WHEREAS, Stillwater Township, by ordinance, has duly enacted a recycling plan for all recyclable materials as designated by the Sussex County District Solid Waste Management Plan and amendments thereto and:

WHEREAS, Stillwater Township is desirous of retaining CRP services of the SCMUA for certification of said Annual Recycling Tonnage Report; and:

WHEREAS, the award of this contract between the SCMUA and Stillwater Township pursuant to N.J.S.A. Section 13:1E-99.14 and pursuant to N.J.S.A. Section 40A:11-5(2). is an exception to the bidding requirements as set forth in the "Local Public Contracts Law";

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, conditions, mutual benefits and covenants hereinafter set forth, that Stillwater Township and the SCMUA make this agreement.

- Stillwater Township shall retain the services of the SCMUA for a
 CRP that will be responsible for executing the mandatory annual
 municipal recycling tonnage report, as provided in the Sussex
 County District Solid Waste Management Plan, and with the State
 NJDEP.
- It is understood that the responsibility for the accuracy of all tonnage and materials reported lies with the municipal representative as the designated preparer of the Recycling Tonnage Report. Stillwater Township designates: Joseph Funari, Stillwater Township Recycling Coordinator, as the preparer of the report. The Municipal report preparer is responsible for report verification should the NJDEP audit the report submittal.
- Stillwater Township shall be responsible to retain the appropriate documentation for five years in the event of a NJDEP field review/audit.

- 4. Stillwater Township reserves the right to reasonably amend the terms of this Agreement by giving thirty (30) day written notification to the SCMUA of any changes thereto. The SCMUA reserves the right to terminate this Agreement if the amendment is unacceptable to the SCMUA.
- 5. Stillwater Township shall pay an annual fee of \$300.00 to the SCMUA for the CRP's services. Stillwater Township agrees to pay all invoices within thirty (30) days upon finalization of the report and submittal of voucher. Notwithstanding any other provision herein. The SCMUA's liability arising out of this agreement for any reason whatsoever, whether known or unknown shall never be greater than the annual fee.
- This agreement is effective for calendar year 2023 (2022 Recycling Tonnage Report), and may be extended for future years, in yearly increments, upon the mutual consent of both parties.
- 7. This agreement is the entire agreement between Stillwater Township and the SCMUA and supersedes all previous agreements and discussions. Any amendments hereto must be in writing and must be duly executed by both Stillwater Township and the SCMUA to become effective.
- 8. This Agreement will be entirely performed within the State of New Jersey and it shall be construed in accordance with the laws thereof.

9. If any provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, void, ultravires, or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.
