



## CERT Basic Training Course

CERT Basic Training prepares you to help yourself, family, friends and neighbors in the event of a disaster. Because emergency services personnel will not be able to help everyone immediately, you can make the difference by using your CERT Training to save lives and protect property. Trained CERT volunteers can fan-out within their assigned areas, extinguish small fires, turn off natural gas at damaged homes, perform light search and rescue, and administer basic medical treatment.

CERT also acts as effective “eyes and ears” for uniformed emergency responders. Trained CERT volunteers offer an important workforce to service the community in non-hazardous functions such as shelter support, crowd control, evacuation, and community service educational programs.

With training and practice, and working as a team, you will be able to protect yourself and maximize your capability to help the greatest number of people after a disaster or life-threatening emergency.
