**RESOLUTION 2026-014**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STILLWATER AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR OR CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO IMPOSE A SERVICE CHARGE TO AN ACCOUNT FOR WHICH A CHECK OR OTHER WRITTEN INSTRUMENT WAS RETURNED FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS**

**WHEREAS**, P.L. 2090, Chapter 105, supplementing Title 40 of the New Jersey State Revised Statutes has been enacted to allow a municipality the authority to impose a service charge to be added on an account which was by check or other written instrument returned for insufficient funds; and,

**WHEREAS**, whenever an account is owing a municipality for property tax, municipal utility charges or special assessment, the service charge authorized by this section shall be included on whatever list of delinquent accounts is prepared for the enforcement of the lien.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Stillwater that the Tax Collector or Chief Financial Officer be authorized to charge the aforementioned fee at a rate of \$25.00 per check or other written instrument for all checks returned for insufficient funds during the year; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Tax Collector or Chief Financial Officer may require future payments to be tendered in cash or by certified or cashier's check; and,

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Chief Financial Officer, Tax Collector, and the Township Auditor.
