Thank you to the CERT volunteers who helped with setup and cleanup.
- March 13, Maureen held a meeting with Doug and Neil on to disuse their responsibilities if CERT is called out in her absences. Accountability procedures, notification procedures, and necessary paperwork packets were handed out to each. Maureen sent out to all active CERT volunteers the steps they need to follow if called out to respond during her absence. Any questions or concerns are to be sent to Maureen.
- Maureen and Lisa spoke more in detail about the CERT volunteers Background Checks necessary prior to receiving the CERT ID cards. Later that week Maureen then spoke to the CFO, Tammy, about the discussion. Tammy requested a copy of the CERT volunteer roster which was given to her at that time.
